

Admission and Training

8th pass youth in age group 18-28 years with English as a subject.

Mode of Selection

- i) Publicity through advertisement in national and local newspapers.
- ii) Personal interview on first come first serve basis.
- iii) Selection by committee of IITTM representatives and external industry experts.
- iv) Merit list and waiting list is to be prepared. Candidates from waiting list to be taken in case of no show or drop outs (within 2 days of commencement of the courses).
- v) **There would be no rejection of candidates.** If number of candidates are more, additional batches can be made but with the prior approval of MoT.

Application fee

There will be no application / course chargeable to the trainees.

Boarding and Lodging

No boarding and Lodging will be provided. The trainees will have to make their own arrangements for Boarding and Lodging during the training period.

Stipend

A trainee with a minimum attendance of 90% will be paid lump sum stipend of Rs. 1,500/- at the end of programme.

Certification

The trainees with minimum attendance of 90% will be required to appear in the end of the course test – practical and viva-voce. Those who pass the test successfully will be awarded certificates jointly by MoT and IITTM. For the purpose of this test, there will be a panel of examiners, one internal and one external examiner to be drawn by nodal officers of the IITTM, campuses in consultation with Director, IITTM. The Director, IITTM will have the discretion for the reasons to be recorded in writing to relax attendance norm by 10% for the purpose of stipend and appearance in test.

Employment Notification

IITTM, will make conscious efforts to facilitate employment of the pass-outs from this programme. Efforts will also be made to organize campus recruitment by stake holders in the trade.
